Who we are



We are **Peninsula Transport**. We work in Cornwall, Devon, Plymouth, Somerset and Torbay. We call these places the **Peninsula area**.



We are a **Sub-National Transport Board**, also called an **STB**. We work with **transport** companies and the Government to make transport in the Peninsula area better.



Transport is what you use to get around the Peninsula area. For example, buses, trains, cars, bikes or by walking.



We want to make transport in the Peninsula area better for everyone by the year 2050.

This booklet is about our plan to make transport better in the Peninsula area.



We have 4 **outcomes** in our plan. **Outcomes** are what we want our plan to do.



We will tell you what the outcomes are and what they mean.



We will tell you what we have done so far and what we will do next.

Our 4 Outcomes



1

Easier Journeys. We want to make journeys easier for everyone on trains and buses, in cars and for people who walk or cycle.

Going Electric. We want more people to use electric cars and we want our trains and buses to be better for the **environment**. **Environment** means everything around us including the air, water, plants and animals.

A Connected Peninsula. We want it to be easier for people to travel into and around the Peninsula area and for people to get to airports and train stations more easily.

Completing the Transport Network. We want the roads, trains and buses to be safe and last a long time.

What we have done so far



We did a lot of **research** into how we can make transport better.



Research is when people collect information to help them think about problems and find ways to fix them.



We found out who we need to ask for money to make transport better and how to ask for it.



We worked with train companies to try to make it easier to use your mobile phone or computer on trains.

What we want to do



We want to make it easier for you to get to the places you need to go to.



We want to make sure buses and trains work well and that roads are safe and looked after.



We want to reduce **pollution** from transport. **Pollution** is when cars and other vehicles use fuels like petrol and diesel which make the air dirty.



We want to help people in the Peninsula area to be happy and healthy and want to live and work here.

How we will make our outcomes happen and how they will help you



We already have good transport in the Peninsula area, but our plan is to make transport better.

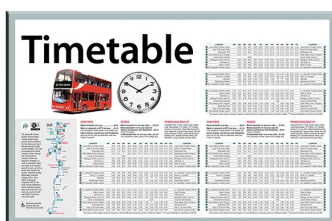


By the year 2030 we want to

- make it easier to walk or cycle to bus stops and train station.



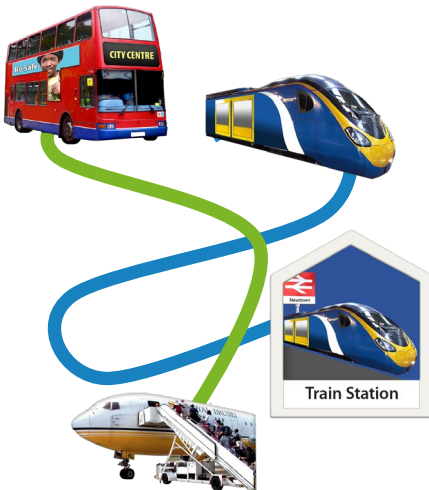
- make it cost less money for you to get a train or a bus.



- make it easier to find information about the train or bus you need.



- make sure there are more places to charge your electric car and buy more electric buses that are better for the environment.



- make it easier to visit other places in the Peninsula area by train or bus and make it easier to get to train stations and airports.



Between the years 2023 and 2035 we want to make sure everyone has a better choice of transport to use and knows about the different types of transport.

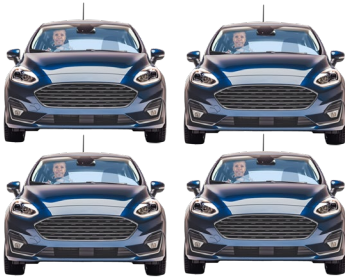


After the year 2035 we want all transport in the Peninsula area to be cleaner and better for the environment.

Changes we want to make that will be hard to do



Some of the changes we want to make will be hard because we will need a lot of money or they will take a long time. We want to



- make sure there are enough places to charge your electric car.



- make sure trains run on time.



- make people want to use trains or buses instead of their cars.



- make it easier for people who live in the countryside to get to towns and cities.



- make sure there are enough trains and buses for people who come here on holiday in the Summer.



- make it easier and cheaper to buy a bus ticket.



- make sure all the roads in the area are safe and do not have to be closed to be fixed.



- Make sure lorries can safely travel on roads and do not make it harder for cars to use the roads.

What we will do in the next year



We will write a plan to make it easier to use buses.



We will find out where people want to charge their electric cars.



We will work to get more rail stations and better roads and try to make our roads safer.



We will talk to other STB's to find out how to make transport better.
